Safety Precautions

Please read the following precautions before startup.



Do use the AC adapter that comes with this device. Use of other AC adapter may lead to malfunction, heat up, electrical shock, fire, or injury.



Do not install any heat sources such as radiators or other devices near NVR.



When cleaning the product, use a dry cloth to wipe the exterior of the device.



Do not disassemble or attempt to fix or alter the product yourself.



Keep the power cord straight and without being twisted, bended, or scraped.



Damaged wire could cause fire or electrical shock.

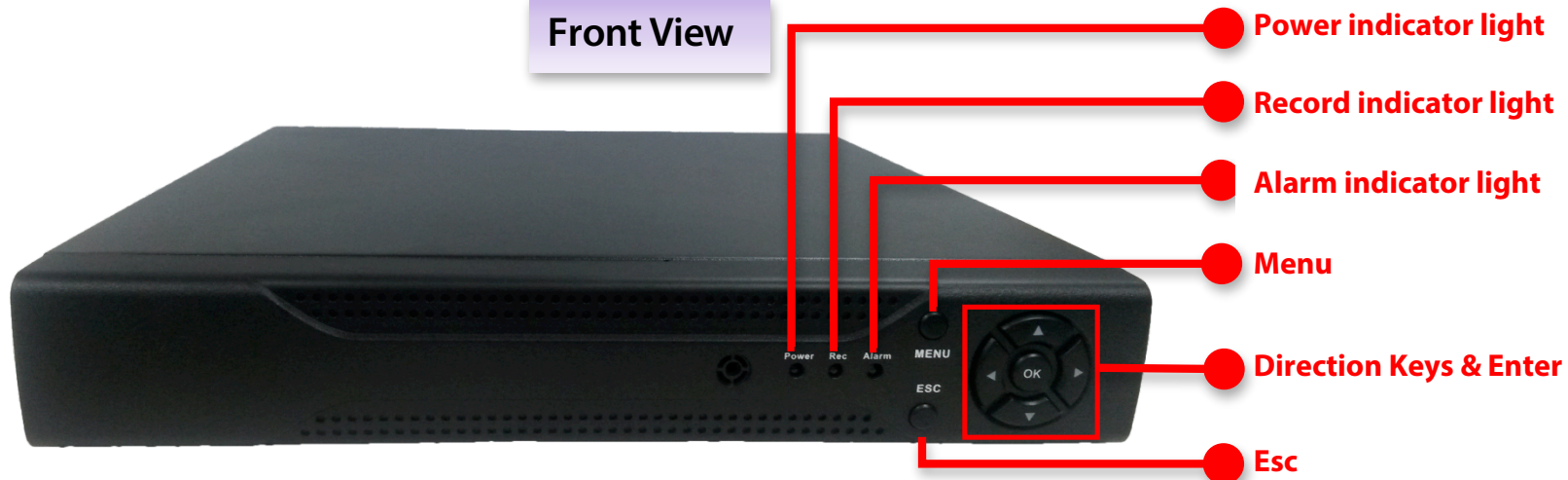


Make sure that the product is switched off before you install it.

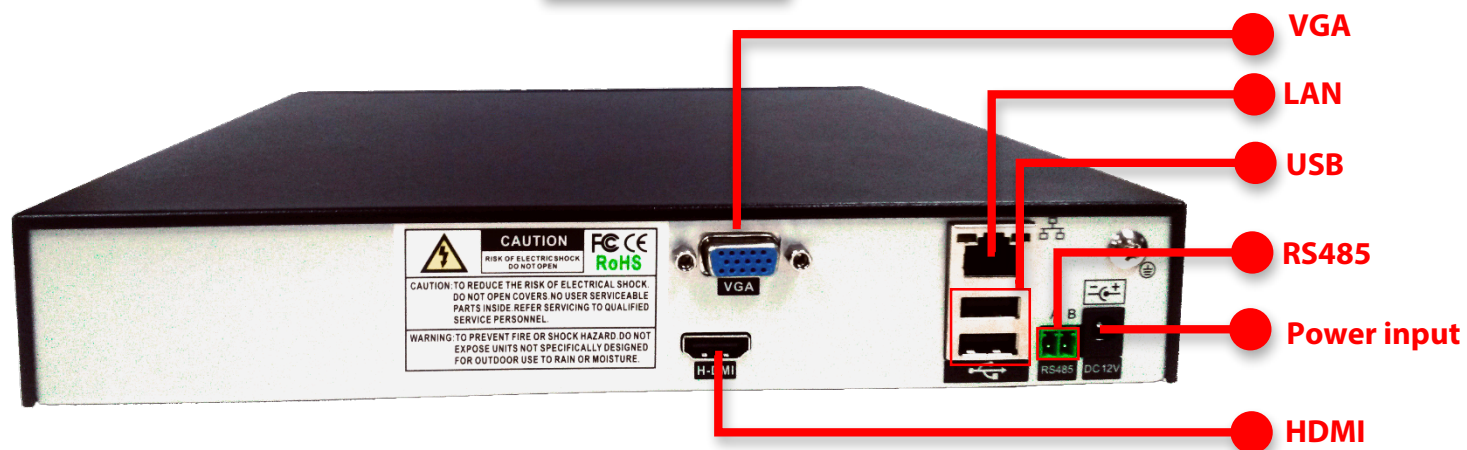


Make sure that the room temperature is lower than 35°C (95°F).

Cover the device



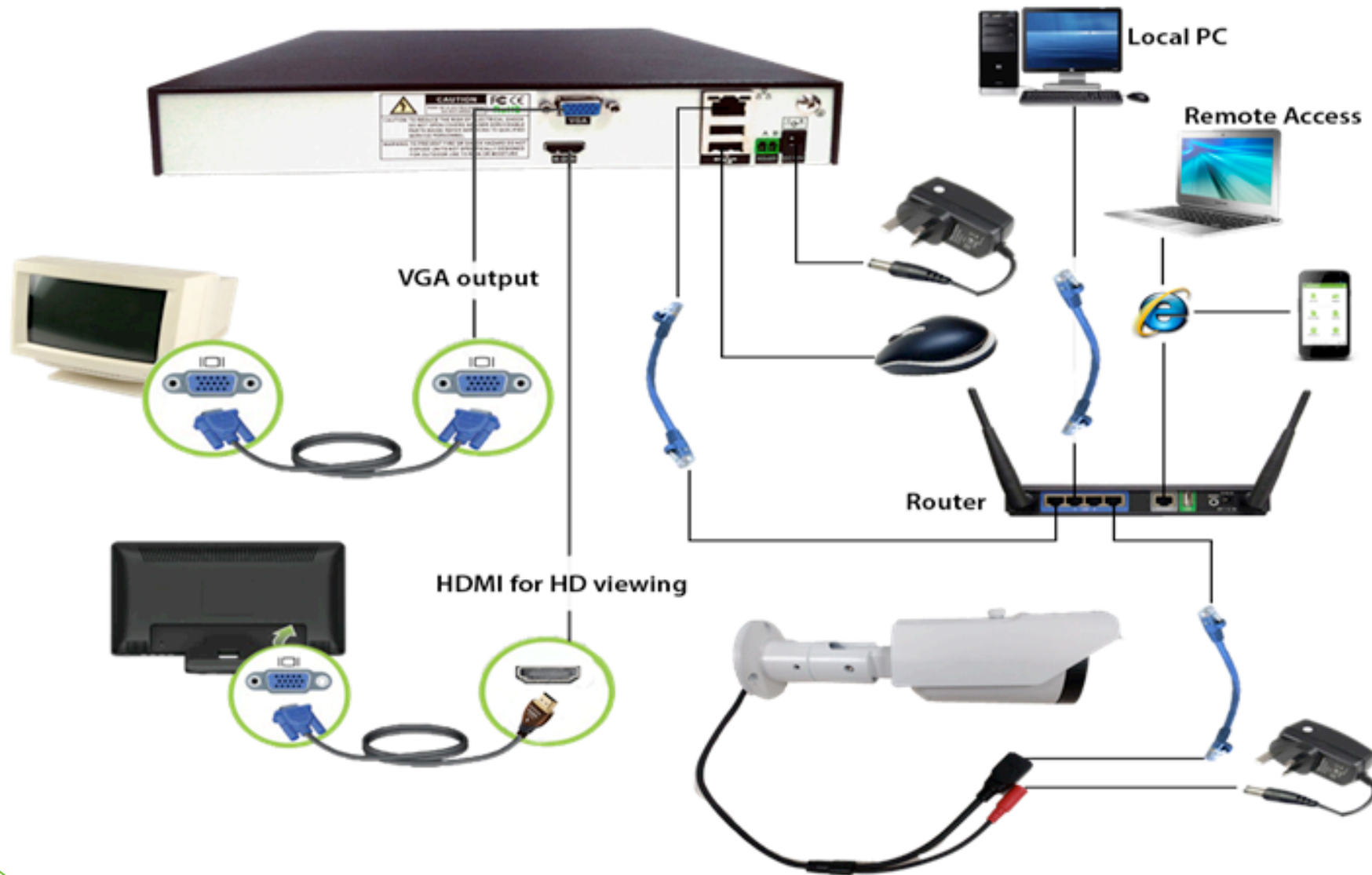
Connect the power wire



Connect the data wire

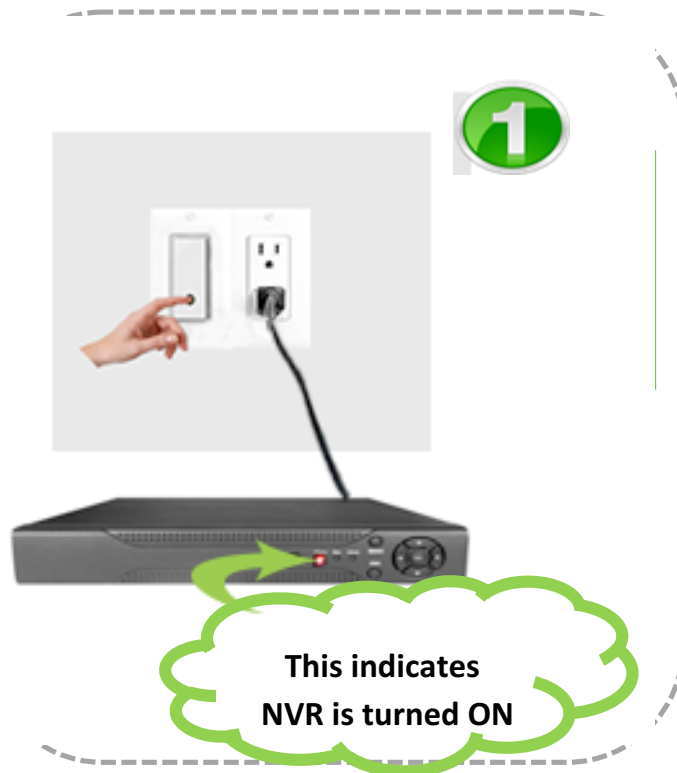
Basic Connection

The figure below shows the basic connection of NVR with IP camera.



Power ON

After connecting the camera and NVR as per the above connection diagram, please follow the below steps for power ON.



Note:



Make sure that the input voltage corresponds with the switch of the NVR power supply.
Power supply demands: 220V \pm 10% /50Hz.

Searching device in Software-Auto-Connected Model

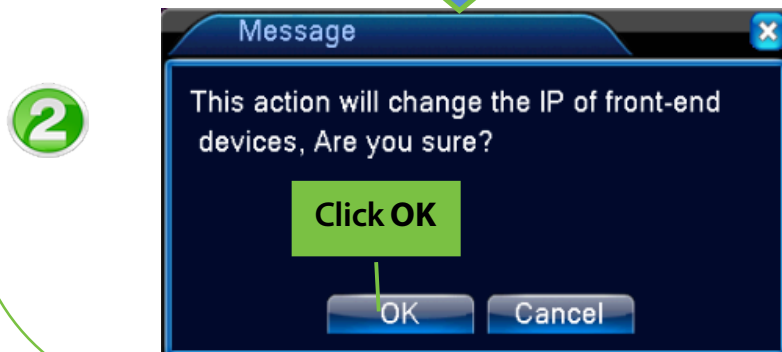
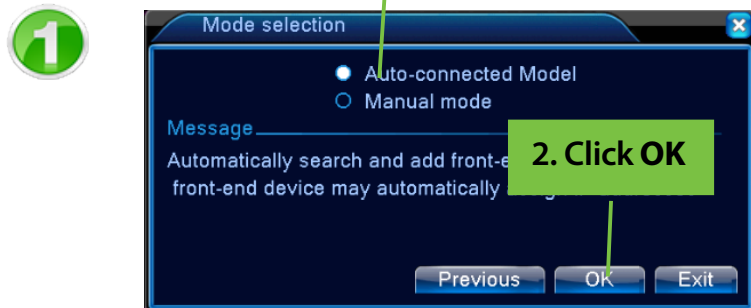
After NVR is powered ON, you need to select the mode for searching the device in the software.

There are two modes:

- Auto-connected model
- Manual mode

For searching the device in Auto-Connected Model, follow the below steps.

1. After NVR is powered ON, mode selection dialog will be displayed. Select **Auto-Connected Model**.

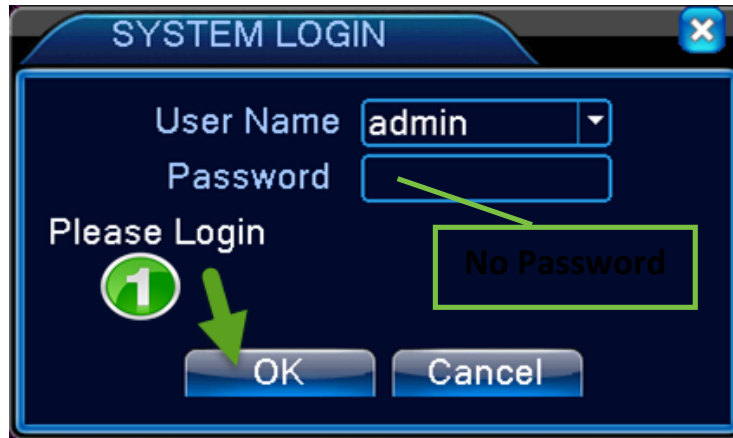

Searching Device in Software - Manual Mode

For searching the device manually using software, follow the below steps.



When NVR boots up, the user must login and the system provides the corresponding functions with the user purview.

While startup, default user will be admin with no password.

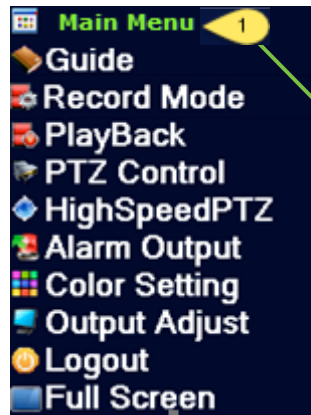


1	Channel name and status display, click on the "channel" can be folded up.	4	Page flip up and down, when choosing a 16 channel, operation can be performed.

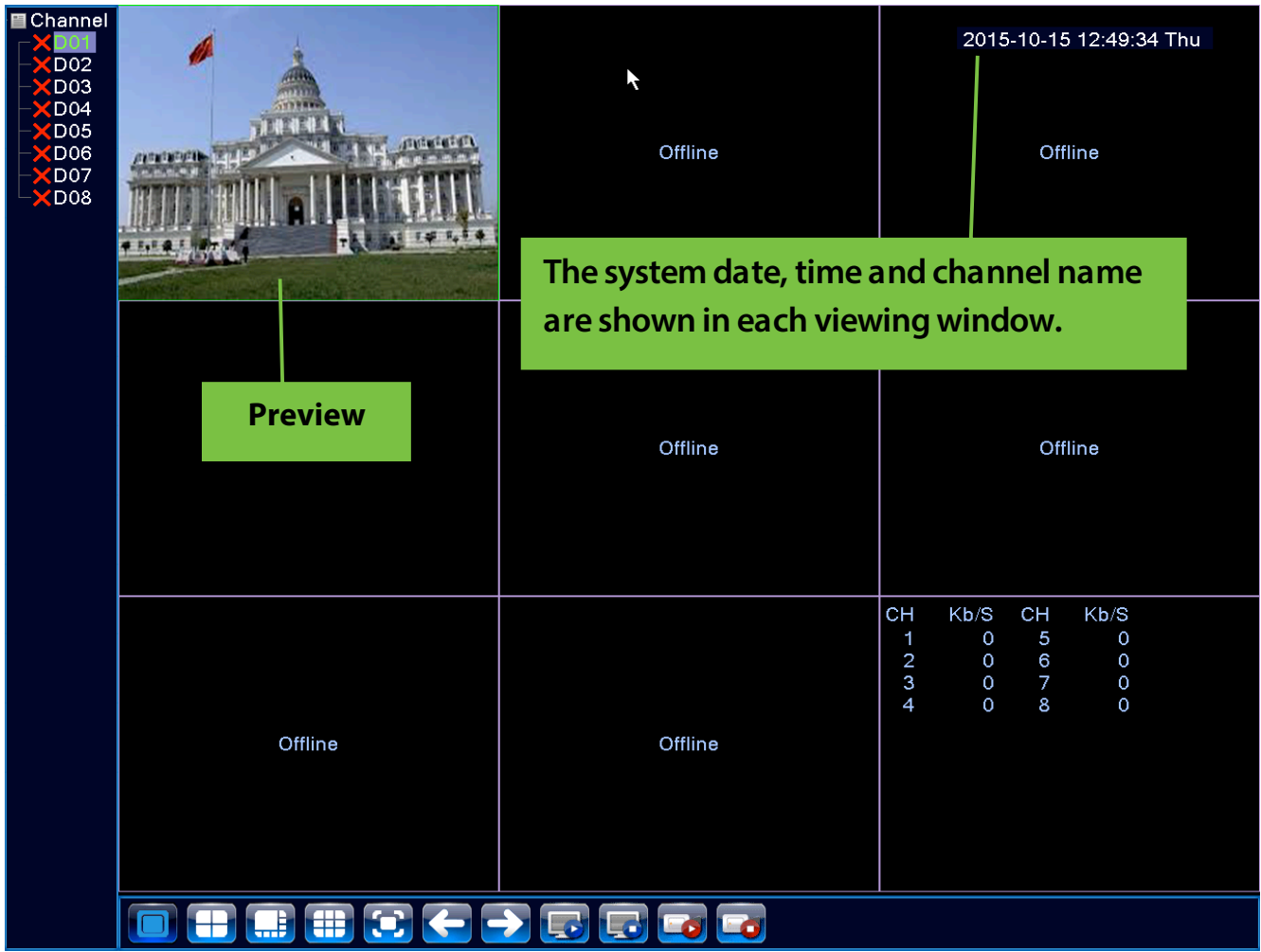
